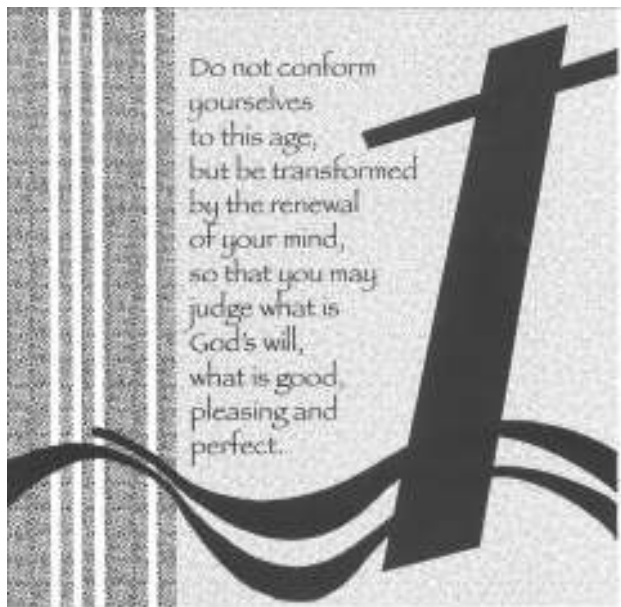

**Day of Adoration** is this Friday, September 4. First Friday Mass for parishioners is at 7:30 am. Mass for faculty and students is at 8:15 am. Adoration will begin at 9:00 am after Mass and end with 6:30 pm Rosary led by parishioners followed by Benediction. Fr. Kelechi will be available for Confessions at 3:30 and 6:30 pm. **Rectory Updates & Repairs** The Pastoral Council and Administration Commission have determined that the bathrooms are in need of major updates immediately. Photos are in back of church. The projected costs per bathroom is estimated at \$10,000 assuming there are no serious unforeseen issues. Plans are to begin with Fr. Kelechi's bathroom on the main floor and proceed as money is available. Other updates are advised, but not as urgent. Donations are needed to accomplish this. **School News:** Students will be attending Mass on Thursdays and Fridays each week. **We ask parishioners to refrain from attending at the present time because of limited safe space.**

**Confirmation** The current students will make their Confirmation on Sunday, October 6, 2020. The next class is September 9. A new Confirmation Class will begin in the fall of 2021. Details of the ages and grade levels accepted for this class will be announced closer to that date.

Confirmation is NOT a Catholic "rite of passage" wherein one makes a "choice" to become a "full, adult member of the faith." Confirmation is a sacrament of strengthening which fortifies those initial graces bestowed upon the faithful at baptism and nourished through regular reception of the Holy Eucharist at Mass. God is confirming the grace of Baptism on them at Confirmation.

Confirmation is a time to lead "the Christian toward a more intimate union with Christ and a more lively familiarity with the Holy Spirit, his actions, his gifts and his callings, in order to be more capable of assuming the responsibilities of Christian life."

**PSR (Parish School of Religion):** Registration forms for PSR are in the back of church for grades K through 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Fees are \$25 for the first child, \$10 each additional child to cover supplies and material needed for class. Please place the registrations in the collection basket or give to Paula Wright. **As Catholic Parents,** we know that our child's soul is the most important part of the body but sometimes we put off nurturing it in favor of more immediate priorities. Give religious education class the same priority as any other class. Don't let him miss class. **Show by example.** Make sure to show your child ways to live the faith. Discuss what you do to keep your own soul healthy and strong. **Daily exercise is key.** We only get better by practice. Make sure your child practices his faith every day. Prayer and service to others are two easy ways to start.
