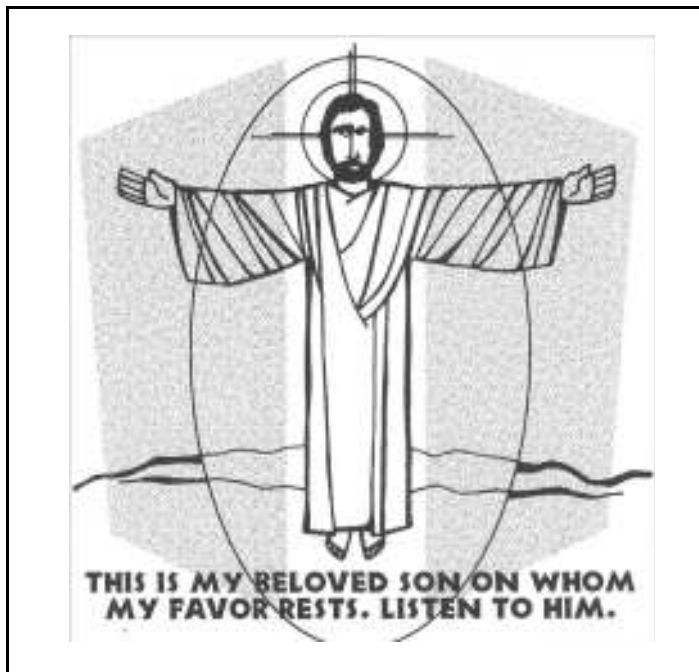

**Abstinence:** All persons over their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.

**Fasting:** Everyone from their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday, through 59<sup>th</sup> birthday is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting is generally understood to mean eating only one full meal each day. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed.

**Debt Reduction Envelope** is in your March packet. This envelopes is used to pay off our loan to the Diocese. Currently we make monthly payments of \$150.46 and owe approximately \$9,500.00 on the \$20,000 school building loan incurred in 2017. Your contributions will help to meet these obligation.
