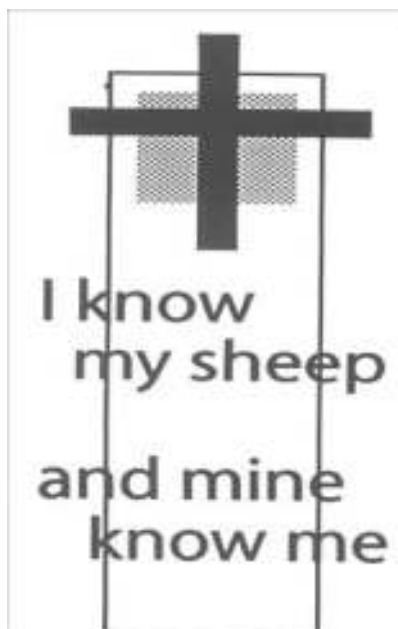

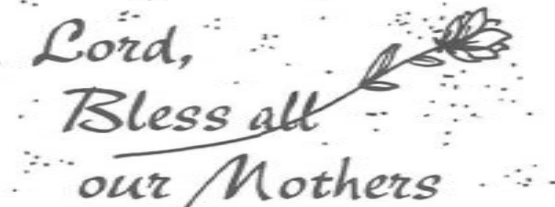

This change will be effective when an article is published in the Catholic Missourian in the near future. The customary offering for a Mass intention will be \$10.
