Abstinence: All persons over their 14th birthday are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.

Fasting: Everyone from their 18th birthday, through 59th birthday is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting is generally understood to mean eating only one full meal each day. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed.
