Attending Mass Again If you have been away from Mass since the start of the pandemic, our parish is doing much to keep everyone safe. All those attending are asked to make sure they are healthy before they come to Mass (take your temperature), wear masks, use sanitizer and/or wipes when they enter, wipe down the pew area when they arrive and before they leave, maintain safe distancing (utilizing every other pew) and the church is sanitized after use. Approximately 170 people are attending Mass regularly but there is still room at all Masses for a few more people. If you feel you would like to return, just follow all the procedures and come to the Mass you are the most comfortable with. You do not need to call to make reservations. We look forward to the time when we can all return to Mass without fear of contamination.
