**National Vocation Awareness Week** is November 1 – 6. **Day of Adoration** is Friday, November 6. **Mass is at 7:00 am** Adoration will begin after Mass and end with Rosary at 6:30 pm led by parishioners followed by Benediction. Fr. Kelechi will NOT be available for Confessions at 3:30 pm. Please sign up for a time of prayer on the clipboard on the table when you come into church. If you don't have the chance to sign up, please come at any time to join other parishioners in prayer. This is the month of All Souls. We remember those who have gone before us, our loved ones and fellow parishioners.

**Rectory Updates & Repairs** We have received a total of \$26,862 for rectory repairs as of October 26. Thank you for your generosity. The main bathroom has been completed. We are awaiting the final cost of this before progressing to the next improvement project.

**Attending Mass Again** If you have been away from Mass since the start of the pandemic, our parish is doing much to keep everyone safe. All those attending are asked to make sure they are healthy before they come to Mass (take your temperature), wear masks, use sanitizer and/or wipes when they enter, wipe down the pew area when they arrive and before they leave, maintain safe distancing (utilizing every other pew) and the church is sanitized after use. Approximately 170 people are attending Mass regularly but there is still room at all Masses for a few more people. If you feel you would like to return, just follow all the procedures and come to the Mass you are the most comfortable with. You do not need to call to make reservations. We look forward to the time when we can all return to Mass without fear of contamination. **Mass Schedule for Christmas** Knowing that priests are allowed to say only 2 Masses on Christmas Eve and 2 Masses on Christmas Day, the Liturgy Committee recommended and the Pastoral Council approved the Mass schedule as follows: **Mass on Christmas Eve is 5:30 pm with Christmas Day at 8:00 am.**

**Mass at Brookfield on Christmas Eve is scheduled for 7:30 pm with Christmas Day Mass at 9:30 am.**
