Day of Adoration is this Friday, September 4. **First Friday Mass for parishioners is at 7:30 am.** Mass for **faculty and students only** is at 8:15 am. Adoration will begin at 9:00 am after Mass and end with Rosary at 6:30 pm led by parishioners followed by Benediction. Fr. Kelechi will be available for Confessions at 3:30 and 6:30 pm. Please sign up for a time of prayer on the clipboard on the table when you come into church. If you don't have the chance to sign up, please come at any time to join other parishioners in prayer. This would be a good time to remember all our students from preschool through college. Also, we must continue to pray for all those who have contacted Covid, all those who deal daily with the disease, doctors, nurses, hospitals, and all who make decisions to work at keeping us healthy and yet not entirely isolated from society. And we can ask God to take the pandemic away.

Rectory Updates & Repairs The Pastoral Council and Administration Commission have determined that the bathrooms are in need of major updates immediately. Photos are in back of church. In the main bathroom, the stool and the bath tub are stained. The vanity is moisture damaged. The towel rack is coming off the wall (and if it could have been repaired, Fr. Jerry would have done it.) The shower curtain rod is sagging. And it is very obvious that the 1956-57 model has been well used. Plans are to begin with Fr. Kelechi's bathroom on the main floor and proceed as money is available. The projected costs per bathroom is estimated at \$10,000 assuming there are no serious unforeseen issues. Other updates are advised, but not as urgent. Donations are needed to accomplish this. If you would like to make a donation, please mark it "Rectory Repair". Parish School of Religion (PSR): plan to begin on Wednesday, September 16 at 6:00 pm at Fr. McCartan School. Any child, from Kindergarten through 8th grade who is not a student at Fr. McCartan School, is encouraged to attend. As Catholic parents, we know that our child's soul is the most important part of the body, but sometimes we put off nurturing it in favor of more immediate priorities. PSR gives parents the opportunity to nurture the soul. Denying a child a proper academic education is unthinkable, so make sure the faith opportunity of PSR is utilized. Give religious education class the same priority as any other essential subject. Registration forms are on the table in back of church or on the website. They may be returned to the rectory or to Paula Wright with the proper fee of \$25 for the first student and \$10 for each additional child.

Envelopes: Envelope packets are sent monthly to parishioners that include Sunday and special collections as well as School Fund and Debt Repayment envelopes. A number of parishioners are donating through ACH or other means and no longer use their envelopes. Others prefer to give monthly or annually. If you do not use your envelopes and wish to cancel that service, please contact the rectory by phone or with a note in the collection or by email stbonmarceline@gmail.com . Attending Mass Again If you have been away from Mass since the start of the pandemic, our parish is doing much to keep everyone safe. All those attending are asked to make sure they are healthy before they come to Mass (take your temperature), wear masks, use sanitizer and/or wipes when they enter, wipe down the pew area when they arrive and before they leave, maintain safe distancing (utilizing every other pew) and the church is sanitized after use. There is still room at all Masses for a few more people. If you feel you would like to return, just follow all the procedures and come to the Mass (except student Masses) you are the most comfortable with. You do not need to call to make reservations. We look forward to the time when we can all return to Mass without fear of contamination.
