
Butterfly Quilt

Approximate Finished Size: 59" X 71"



Fabric Requirements: Fabric strips...36 2 ½" strips Background fabric ... 2 1/2 yards includes binding. 3rd Border fabric... 1 ½ yards

Key

WOF=Width of Fabric **LOF**= Length of Fabric

Cut Fabric

Background Fabrics A, B, C

• Butterfly fabric – Use strip set or cut 36 2 ½" strips 12 each of light (A), medium (B), dark (C).

Background Fabric D

- Background corners cut 96 2½" x 2½" squares.
- Butterfly centers cut 12 11/2" x 121/2"strips.
- Vertical sashing cut eight 2.5 x 12 ½ vertical sashing.
- Horizontal sashing Cut four 2.5 x 42 ½" WOF horizontal sashing.
- First Border... cut seven 2 ½" strips WOF.
- Binding...8 2.5" strips.


Backing This quilt fits on one width of Minky backing.

Build Butterfly Block

- 1) Sew three strips together WOF.
- 2) Cut four 6 ½" squares from each strip set.

Reserve leftover strip set units for 2nd scrap border.

3) Assemble 12 blocks using four matching 6 1/2" square units per block:




- a) Sew 2 ½" Fabric D squares diagonally to upper right and lower left corners of 2 units.
- b) Sew 2 ½" Fabric D squares to upper *left* and lower *right* corners of 2 units.
- c) Arrange two unit with matching a horizontal unit to a vertical as shown:
- d) Join the two units using $1 \frac{1}{2}$ butterfly center strips to finish block.

Create Scrap Border

- Cut reserved leftover strip set units into 2 ½" pieces. 1)
- 2) Sew the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ scrap units into four border strips approximately 63" long each.

Assemble Quilt

- Rows: Join three butterfly blocks with vertical sashing to make one row. 3) Make four rows.
- 4) Join the four rows with horizontal sashing.
- 5) Borders: Sew borders to sides first then top and bottom.
 - a) Add 1st 2 ½" border strips of background fabric all around.
 - b) Add 2nd 2 ½" scrap border all around.
 - c) Add 3rd 4 1/2" border strips all around.
- Quilt and bind. 6)
