Lorali Panel Couch Quilt

Approximate Finished Size: 58-59" X 72-75"



Fabric Requirements:

Loralie panel...24" x 42" Sashing and 1st border fabric...1 ¼ yard 2nd border fabric... 2 yards Binding... 2/3 yards

Key

WOF=Width of Fabric LOF= Length of Fabric

Cut Fabric

This pattern is designed to work with horizontal panels designed by Loralie Designs panels that are approximately 40" wide by 24" tall.

Loralie Designs Panel ... cut two panels to approximately 24 x 36 wide. (*Remove a column of blocks from the same side of each panel or opposite ends of panels to stagger panels. Reserve cut blocks for corners.*)

Sashing, First, and Third Border... strips can be from 3.5" to 4.5" depending on how big you want your quilt.

- Cut one strip WOF for sashing.
- First Border
 - $\,\circ\,$ Cut Five WOF strips the same size as sashing.
- Third Border
 - $\,\circ\,$ Cut Seven WOF strips the same size as sashing.

2nd Border...

- Cut 4 strips WOF to same *width* of corner blocks.
- Cut 2-3 strips WOF to the same *height* as corner blocks. (Some corner blocks widths maybe be equal size width and height (e.g. 5" wide x 5" tall) and some may be taller or wider than the width. (e.g. 7" wide x 8" tall))

Binding...8 2.5" strips

Backing...Not included

This quilt is designed to fit on one width of Minky backing.

Quilt Assembly

- 1) Join two panels with horizontal sashing.
- 2) Add 1st border strips all around. *Sew to sides first then top and bottom.*
- 3) Add 2nd border strips to sides.
- 4) For top and bottom 2nd borders, measure from edge of left side first border to right side of first border and add ½" for seam allowance. Attach corner blocks.



- 5) Add 2nd top and bottom borders.
- 6) Add 3rd border strips all around. *Sew to sides first then top and bottom.*
- 7) Quilt and bind.
