to 1800.00 with no vault and 2000.00 with a vault. This will cover lines <1 inch, anything >than1 inch will have an evaluation for additional cost of labor and materials. Marc is going to reach out to Steve Spokart to see where we are in the process, when Steve turns the project over to Marc, he will draft a letter to the residents in that area to define the process and any potential cost. Sandy Miller made a motion to send a letter to the residents affected by this project contingent on Steve Spokart turning the process over, Karen Gnagey second the motion. Motion passed by all in favor.

G. Melissa Frampton Tap on the Broadway Street Project. Melissa is not happy with where her tap is located. She would like to sell her house. Terry will review with her.

B. Body Harnesses are needed- Terry is able to purchase with no motion needed, they are below the threshold of board approval.


