OERColorado features numerous collections of openly licensed digital resources for use in PreK-12 Colorado Classrooms. The OERColorado Hub is a satellite linked to the extensive OER Commons digital library that houses tens of thousands of accesible and remixable classroom resources, ranging from individual lessons, units of study, openly licensed textbooks, and full courses. Materials come from trusted providers like Colorado University Boulder, the Smithsonian, and Khan Academy to individual creators sharing resources that they have found or that they have published.



Some featured collections of interest to Colorado educators are Virtual Field Trips, CU Boulder's PhET interactive science simulations, Digital Literacy, Career Pathways, OER Full Courses, and the Inside Your Classroom collection focusing on rubrics, checklists and classroom management. We continue to add collections to the Hub.


#### Join a Group


