Water Safety

Reading: Read a water safety book for kids.

Checklist: Review a checklist of things to do before entering water.

Activity: Complete a water safety worksheet.

## Week 5:

**Electrical Safety** 

Video: Watch an electrical safety video.

Discussion: Discuss electrical safety tips and precautions.

## Week 6:

Natural Disaster Safety

Activity: Children will pretend to be a tornado to better understand how to react.

Review: Discuss different types of natural disasters.

Worksheet: Complete a worksheet about natural disaster preparedness.

#### Week 7:

God Gave Me a Body



Vocabulary: Review vocabulary related to strangers.

Activity: Complete an activity about dealing with bribery, lies, and threats.

Discussion: Talk about what to do if faced with dangerous situations involving strangers.

# Week 8:

Safe at Home Alone

Discussion: Talk about home safety when children are alone.

Activity: Complete a "Call 911" sheet, practicing emergency response skills.

## Week 9:

Kitchen Safety

Discussion: Talk about favorite foods and what each child has helped cook at home.

Safety: Discuss common hazards in the kitchen.

Activity: Make chocolate-covered strawberries and bananas while practicing kitchen safety skills.

## Week 10:

Technology, Media & Peer Pressure

Vocabulary: Review technology-related vocabulary.

Activity: Complete a hand-tracing activity.

Discussion: Learn the acronym "THINK" and talk about using media safely.

Peer Pressure: Discuss what peer pressure is and how to handle it.

**Gun Safety** 

Activity: Color a gun safety worksheet.

Video: Watch a "What Gun Safety for Kids" video.

Discussion: We will discuss/review what we have learned this semester and how we

can use it in life
