Class Description:

Our World & Me is an engaging, hands-on class that introduces young learners to geography and the important people who help our communities thrive. Students will explore where they live in the world — from their home and town to their country and planet — while learning basic map skills and global awareness.

In addition, children will discover community helpers such as firefighters, doctors, teachers, farmers, and postal workers, and learn how these helpers serve and support our daily lives. Through crafts, pretend play, maps, and interactive activities, students will build respect, responsibility, and an appreciation for the world around them.

Concept: Understanding place and belonging

Land vs. water

Earth has oceans and continents

Week 3:

Maps Help Us Find Places

Concept: Maps show where things are

Students learn:

What a map is

Symbols & simple map features

Maps help us travel and find places

Week 4:

Continents & Oceans (Intro)

Concept: Earth has large land areas and oceans

Students learn:

There are 7 continents (recognition level)

Oceans cover most of Earth

Animals live in different places

Week 5:

Our Community

Concept: A community is where people live and work together

Students learn:

What makes a community

Places in a community (schools, stores, parks)

Week 6:

Community Helpers: Firefighters & Police

Concept: Helpers keep us safe

Students learn:

Roles of firefighters & police officers

How they help during emergencies

Basic safety awareness

Week 7:

Community Helpers: Doctors & Nurses

Concept: Helpers keep us healthy

Students learn:

How medical helpers care for people

Why checkups are important

Basic health awareness

Week 8:

Community Helpers: Farmers & Food Providers

Concept: People help grow and deliver our food

Students learn:

Where food comes from

Role of farmers and grocery workers

Farm-to-table basics

Week 9:

Community Helpers: Mail Carriers & Builders

Concept: Helpers deliver and build what we need

Students learn:

How mail gets delivered

Builders create homes & roads

Importance of working together

Week 10:

Places Around the World

Concept: People live differently around the world

Students learn:

Different homes and environments

Clothing and foods vary by place

Respect for cultural differences

Week 11:

Caring for Our World

Concept: We take care of Earth

Students learn:

Recycling and reducing waste

Keeping communities clean

Protecting nature and animals

Week 12:

My Community & World Celebration

Concept: We are part of a bigger world

Students learn:

How helpers and communities connect

Appreciation for their place in the world

Confidence sharing what they learned
