Learn the Satin stitch. Work on sewing on buttons.

Week 5:

Work on the Satin stitch.

Week 6:

Learn the Back Stitch.

Week 7:

Work on Back stitch.

Week 8:

Learn French knot.

Week 9:

Work on French knot.

Week 10:

Create a final design to make using all stitches learned.

Week 11:

Work on final design.

Week 12:

Complete/ Share final design.
