Class Description:

This class is perfect for creative kids who enjoy using their hands to build masterpieces. Each week, we'll read a book and then build a Lego creation inspired by the book's theme. At the end of the semester, each child will take home their base plate as a keepsake.

Week 1:

Lego Boat

Book: Where the Wild Things Are

Activity: Each child will receive a baseplate and, after reading the book, will use their imagination to build a boat.

Sharing: At the end of class, each child will share their boat creation.

Week 2:

Lego Fairytale

Book: Little Red Riding Hood

Discussion: Talk about different fairytale books or movies.

Activity: Each child will create their own fairytale scene using Legos.

Sharing: At the end of class, each child will share their fairytale creation.

Week 3:

Lego Dream House

Book: If I Built a House

Discussion: Talk about different features homes can have.

Activity: Each child will build their dream house using Legos.

Sharing: At the end of class, each child will share the features of their dream home.

Week 4:

Lego Cake

Book: Happy Birthday to You

Discussion: Talk about how different families celebrate birthdays.

Activity: Each child will build a Lego cake.

Sharing: At the end of class, each child will share their cake creation.

Week 5:

Space Lego

Book: All About Our Solar System

Discussion: Discuss things that can be found in space.

Activity: Each child will create something from space using Legos.

Sharing: At the end of class, each child will share their space creation.

Week 6:

Building with Legos Upside Down

Book: The Boy Who Learned Upside Down

Activity: Each child will receive a baseplate taped under a table and build a Lego creation upside down.

Sharing: At the end of class, each child will share their upside-down creation.



Week 7:

Lego Bridge

Book: 13 Bridges Children Should Know

Activity: Each child will receive a baseplate taped under a table and build a Lego bridge.

Sharing: At the end of class, each child will share their bridge design.

Week 8:

Lego Mummies & Pyramids

Book: Look Inside Mummies & Pyramids

Activity: Each child will build a Lego pyramid, mummy, or creation of their choice inspired by the book.

Sharing: At the end of class, each child will share their creation.

Week 9:

Lego Robot

Book: Robots, Robots Everywhere

Activity: Each child will create a Lego robot.

Sharing: At the end of class, each child will share their robot with the class.

Week 10:

Lego Beach

Book: Pete the Cat: Pete at the Beach

Activity: Each child will create a beach scene using legos

Sharing: At the end of class, each child will share what they made with the class.

Week 11:

Lego park

Book: A park connects us

Activity: After reading the book, each child will use their imagination to create their favorite park

Sharing: At the end of class, each child will share what they made with the class.



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Week 12:

Make Your Name with Legos

Book: How You Got Your Name

Activity: Each child will spell their name using Legos on a baseplate.

Sharing: At the end of class, each child will share their name creation and take it home as a keepsake!
