Class Description:

This class will help build the foundation for grammatically correct speaking and writing. We will be using repetition, stories, copywork, and memorization to help learn about nouns (common & proper), pronouns, verbs, and sentence types. It sounds very boring but it can get pretty silly and loud! This class will not involve much writing and I can tailor what a student should do based on their skill level. Each week will build upon the last, with repetition of the prior week's definition. Throughout the entire class the students will be encouraged to answer questions in complete sentences. The hope is to do a second class next semester covering the other types of verbs, adjectives, and adverbs.

Week 1:

Introduce the definition of a noun and discuss the differences between common and proper.

Discuss the 4 types of nouns: person, place, thing, and idea.

Focus on examples of people and places.



Begin poem memorization of "The Caterpillar".

Homework: Recite the definition of a noun and give an example of a proper and a common noun of a person (attempt to do at least 3 times before the next class).

Week 2:

Introduce the definition of a noun and discuss the differences between common and proper.

Discuss the 4 types of nouns: person, place, thing, and idea.

Focus on examples of people and places.

Talk about addresses.

Begin poem memorization of "The Caterpillar".

Homework: Recite the definition of a noun and give an example of a proper and a common noun of a place (attempt to do at least 3 times before the next class). Help student write down your address.
