Students need to be able to read and follow directions. They need to be able to handle sharp objects maturely, they will be regularly using scissors, needles, pins, and their sewing machine. They will also need basic cutting, gluing, and drawing skills.

In this class students will learn the ins and outs of their sewing machine, learn how to read patterns, how to upcycle items to give them new life, and how to sew an item for themselves. The students will be sewing a zipper bag, scrunchie, and a pair of leggings or pants (they get to pick). The students will need to purchase their OWN sewing machine for this class if they do not currently have one, in addition to the class supply fees. All of the supplies (aside from the fabric) will be able to be reused in any future sewing classes.
