Start with \$100,000 in virtual cash and then put your trading skills to work! You'll learn how to buy and sell stocks and compete with your classmates and me as you try to trade your way to the top. This is a fun and risk-free way to experience how the stock market really works. You'll make trades of real stocks in real-time in a virtual environment and see your profits and losses each day.

This class uses an easy-to-use simulation that imitates the real-life workings of the stock market. Students can track the profits and losses of their stock investments each day. This class is interactive, not lecture-based, so students will have the opportunity to discuss, share trading experiences, and ask questions. I will help students discover how current events affect stock prices so that they can become more interested in the world around them.

What if you don't know anything about stocks? No worries at all!!! Before we start playing the stock market game you'll learn what a stock is and how to pick great stocks



to invest in. Using video clips, examples of real companies like Google, Nike, and Amazon, as well as engaging handouts, you will quickly be a stock market wiz!

This will be an online class that takes place in an in person, group setting, with Teacher India Horton as the in person teacher aide.

*Our goal is to complete real-life trading in the second semester for those students who are ready.*

If parents are willing to help their kid open a custodial account with a broker, and give them a small amount of money, then they will be able to get started with live trading the second semester. They will want to use a broker that allows fractional investing - kids can buy as little as \$5 of a share of stock.
