Class Description:

Welcome to HCU's Drivers Ed School in partnership with Assis Drivers Training. In this class the students will be studying to take their permit test. Forget about test anxiety! Forgot about making the trip to the DMV, waiting in long lines, or dealing with



distractions while trying to take the test. You will be able to take the test comfortably, right on HCU school campus!

In this class, students will be learning all the South Carolina driving rules and guidelines, taking permit practice tests, and then for those that are 15 and up, taking the actual permit test. Students who have their permit and need to log their driving hours, you will schedule driving time with the teacher. Once you complete your driving hours with HCU, you will NOT need to go to the DMV for your driver's test. You will take your drivers test with the teacher. We are a one-stop shop!

Additional Information

- In order to log your driving hours, you must already have your permit
 - Driving hours will take plae at White Knoll High School
- If you are getting your permit after the Fall semester has ended, you can schedule your driving hours with the teacher.
- If this is successful and a class that gets a good turn out, we will offer it every semester for the foreseeable future.
- If you are looking to get your permit test over the summer of 2024, we have schedule a summer class
- Price includes your driving hours for up to one year. So if you don't get your permit until later, after the semester, you will not have to pay anything additional for your driving hours.

Please be advised that by taking the permit test outside of the DMV, they have a random system. The computer will auto generate a random person to have them take their permit test at the DMV. There is nothing anyone can do about this. If your name is randomly picked, you will unfortunately have to take the test again at the DMV.
