INAUGERAL METRO DISTRICT BOARD ELECTIONS

Elections take place on odd years for the Lyons Ridge Metro District Board. This will be the first time the District has held elections, as there are three candidates vying for two director seats – two existing directors for re-election, and one new hopeful. Elected members will serve a four-year term. The remaining 3 seats have brand new members as of June and those seats will be up for election in 2025.

Ballots will be mailed on April 10 and due by May 2nd. Please make sure to vote!
