Information Regarding Use of Motorized Vehicles

To promote harmonious use of the trails, open spaces, sidewalks, and facilities within Lyons Ridge, the Metropolitan District has compiled the information below with respect to the use of motorized vehicles:

Any type of motorized vehicle is prohibited on any of the Lyons Ridge trails, sidewalks, and facilities.

Per the Lyons Ridge Rules and Regulations, adopted July 19, 2019:

- 3 (f) motorized vehicles of any type are prohibited in parks, open spaces, or on sidewalks, trails, or paths.

And, per the Jefferson County Open Space Regulations, which include open space, parks and trails:

- **C.17. Use of Motorized Vehicles:** It shall be unlawful to operate any motorized vehicle, including but not limited to, one wheels and powered scooters, on Open Space Lands except on designated public roadways. Fine: \$100.00

And, per the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office:

- "Toy vehicles" are human-, gas-, or electric-powered vehicles with wheels typically less than 14 inches in diameter. Toy vehicles include mini-bikes, stand-up scooters, and go-peds. Toy vehicles may not be operated on public roadways but may be operated on private property with the owner's permission. They may not be operated on sidewalks if motorized; they may be operated on sidewalks if human powered.

District parks and facilities are routinely patrolled by local law enforcement agencies and all other applicable rules and regulations to include state statutes or county ordinances will be enforced.

As a friendly reminder, the District facilities are open for use from one half-hour before sunrise until on half-hour after sunset, per section A (1) of the Lyons Ridge Rules and Regulations.
