RE: Important information regarding community public spaces

In response to the state-wide "Stay At Home" order and Jefferson County Public Health's response to COVID-19, the Lyons Ridge Metropolitan District has closed all public meeting areas in the community such as the playgrounds and gazebos.

The trails at Lyons Ridge and Montane remain open per Jefferson County. We strongly encourage the community to stay up-to-date with Jefferson County's guidelines for outdoor recreation:

- DO NOT visit parks and public areas; stay home, seek medical care
- DO NOT gather in groups larger than 4
- Practice social distancing of at least 6' in parks, trailheads, and trails
- Keep dogs on leash at ALL times
- Bring your own hand sanitizer and/or hand washing supplies; many of our parks and restrooms lack running water. Sanitize/wash hands after touching public surfaces such as railings, benches, and handles
- Wear a bandana or face mask; cover your nose and mouth at the trailhead or when passing others on the trail
- **High-risk visitors**, use discretion for park visits and public restroom use

The re-opening of the public areas will be evaluated and decided in accordance with local and state government guidelines. The Lyons Ridge Metropolitan District will follow up with changes and updates in the coming weeks.
