Amén.

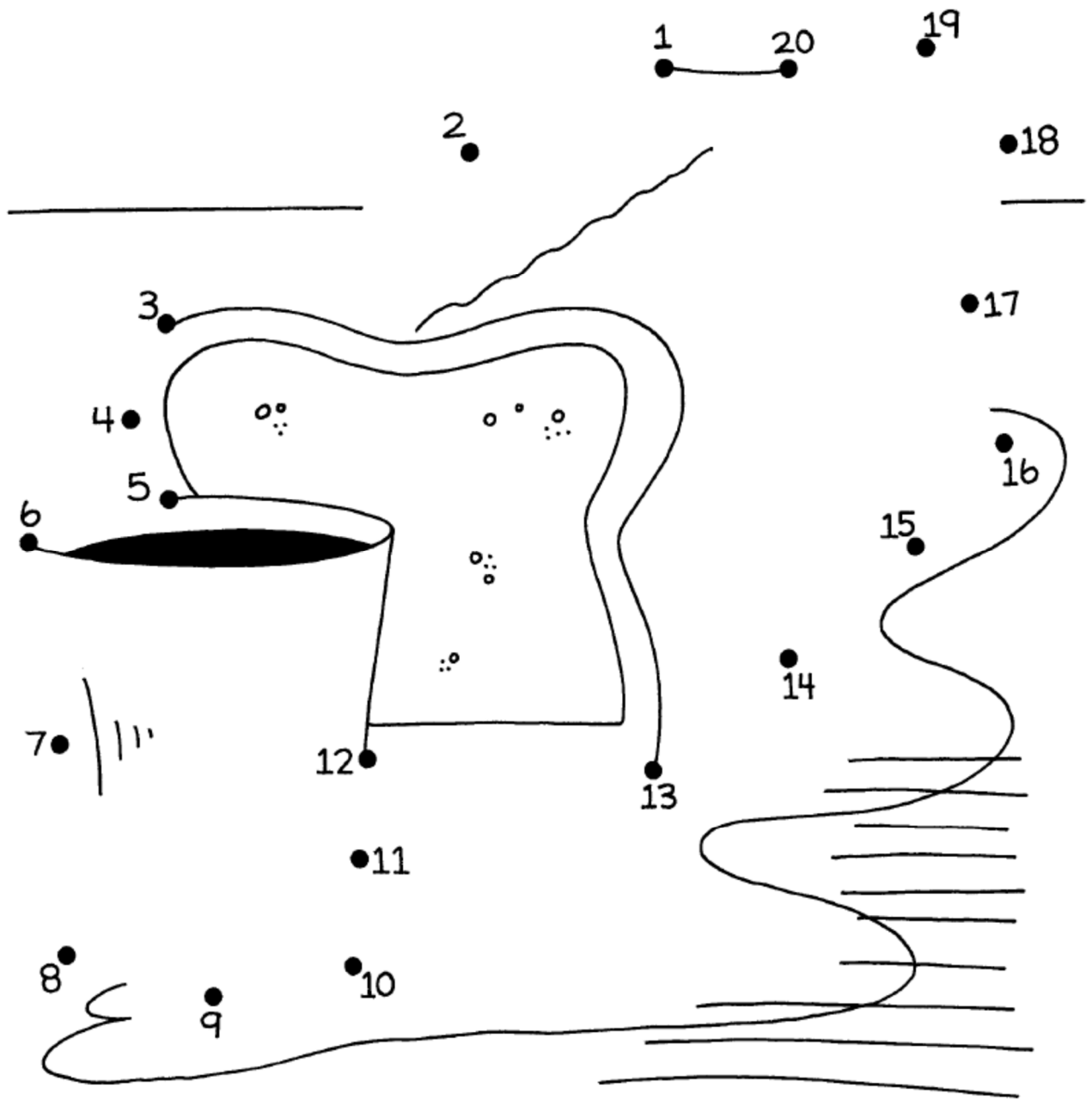
