Learning About God's Love

The Bible tells us all about God's love. It tells us that we are all God's children. He loves us very much. He wants us to love other people.

The more you read the Bible, the more you will learn how much God loves you and how to love God and love others!

Did you know that the Bible has 73 different books? These books are divided into two sections, the Old Testament and the New Testament.

The Old Testament consists of 42 books. These books were written before Jesus was born.

The New Testament consists of 27 books. These books were written after Jesus had risen from the dead. These books teach us about the life of Jesus.

Finding a Bible Passage

We have a special way of finding passages, in the Bible.

↗ **This is the name of the book or Gospel.**

Matthew 22:34-40

↘ **This is the chapter number.**

↘ **These are the verse numbers.**

This passage would be read, "from the Gospel of Matthew, chapter 22, verses 24 through 40."

Now try this one on your own: **Daniel 6:16-28**

How do I know if my Bible is Catholic?

There are so many different versions of Bibles, that it may be confusing to make sure you are reading the correct version. All Catholic Bibles have an imprimatur, which means "let it be printed" in Latin.

The imprimatur is given by a Bishop where the Bible was published indicating that it is approved for printing. You will find the imprimatur on the inside cover, on the title page, or on the back of the title page.

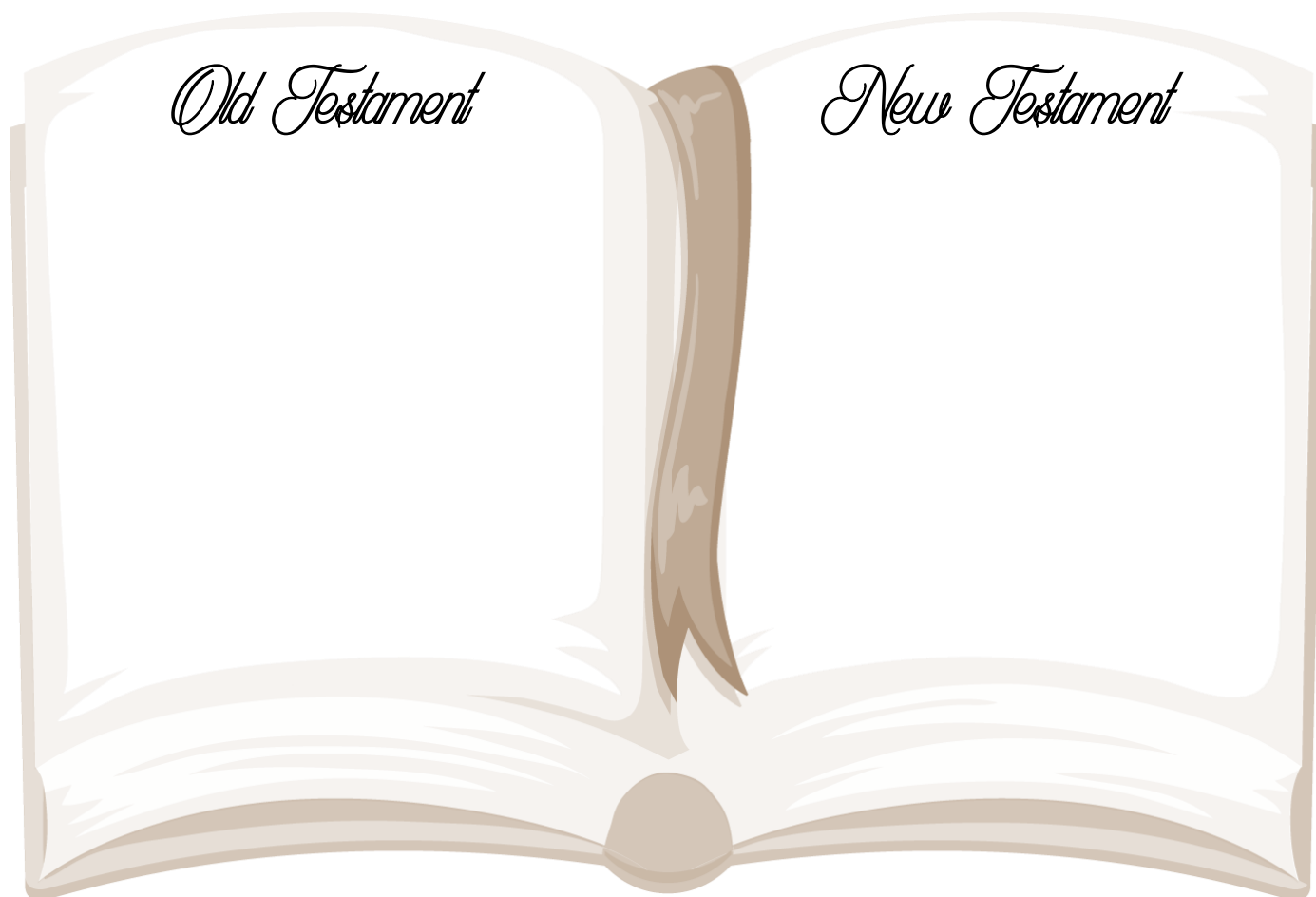
