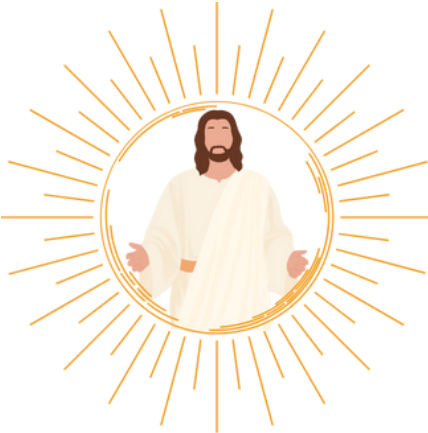

Sacraments of Mercy

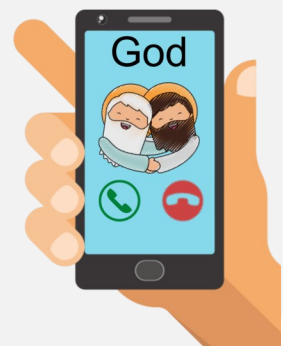
These sacraments remind us that Jesus often forgave and healed others. We celebrate Jesus's healing power.

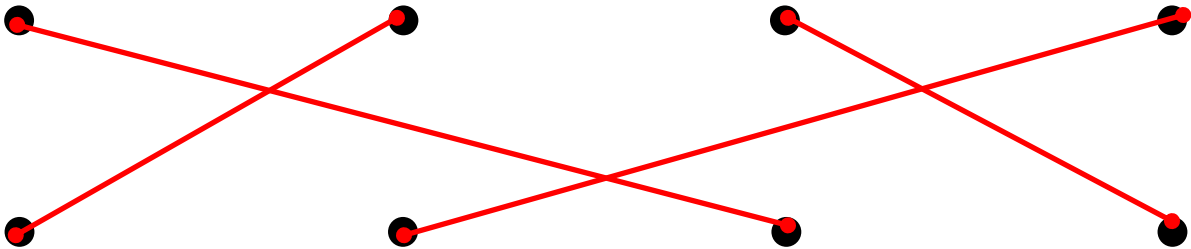

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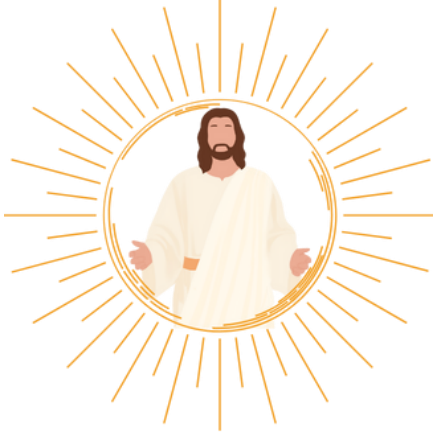
