**A restless heart means that a person feels like something is missing in their life. They may try to find happiness in things like money, fun, or friends, but they never feel completely at peace. St. Augustine realized that only God can truly make him feel true happiness. His heart felt restless because he spent many years searching for happiness in the wrong places. When he finally put his trust in God, he found the peace he was looking for.**

**The child is singing, "Take and read!" He begins reading the scripture he had in his hand and decides to change his life. The scripture said, "Put on the Lord Jesus Christ." He converted to Christianity and was baptized after this experience. Bishop (Saint) Ambrose baptized Augustine, his son and his friend, Alypius.**
