Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS)

All staff at On The Streets Education hold Enhanced DBS clearances. These checks include:

- Police records of convictions, cautions, reprimands, and warnings
- Information held under Section 142 of the Education Act 2002
- Children's Barred List information, confirming whether an individual is barred from working with children
- Any other relevant information disclosed at the discretion of the Chief Police Officer(s), including "soft information"
 - This may include relevant information relating to household members whose circumstances could impact safeguarding (e.g., drug-related activity)

Safeguarding Policies

On The Streets Education's Safeguarding Policy and all core policies are available via the company website and the referrers' platform.

Safeguarding Processes

While the referring school retains ultimate safeguarding responsibility for the children placed with On The Streets Education, we fully implement the requirements of *Keeping Children Safe in Education (KCSIE)*.

- All staff undertake safeguarding training as part of their CPD.
- Clear internal processes are in place for identifying, recording, and escalating safeguarding concerns to the Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL).
- Any concerns are passed to the referring school via the named contact on the referral form.
- The DSL and DDSL hold appropriate safeguarding qualifications and training.
- On The Streets Education uses a secure, certificated cloud-based safeguarding MIS for internal recording.

Where there is **immediate risk of harm**, On The Streets Education will contact the police directly and notify the referring school immediately of all actions taken.

Single Central Record

On The Streets Education maintains a comprehensive Single Central Record, monitored regularly by the Designated Safeguarding Lead. All staff complete annual accredited safeguarding training and receive weekly safeguarding updates
