1. Presence (with individual children, the larger group, colleagues, and other adults).

2. Preparation (sufficiency of preparation and clarity of direction and purpose).



3. Sense of space, movement and gesture (including posture).

4. Speech (attention to mood, tone and grammar, appropriate to age of children, imaginative and lively).

5. Singing (confidence, ability to carry a tune).

6. Storytelling (ability to paint pictures with words).



7. Punctuality, reliability and willingness to work.

8. Appropriateness of dress and grooming.

9. How did student respond to your comments.
