PROTECTING UNACCOMPANIED CHILDREN

House Bill 163

State Representative Kitzman

Relating to the licensing of child-care facilities providing care to certain unaccompanied children and the suspension of laws relating to the licensing of those facilities; creating a criminal offense.

A person who provides 24-hour care under a contract with the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement or the Office of Refugee Resettlement to children who are <u>not accompanied</u> by or in the physical custody of a parent, guardian, or other adult family member <u>must be licensed or certified as a residential child-care facility.</u>

This offense would be a state jail felony.
