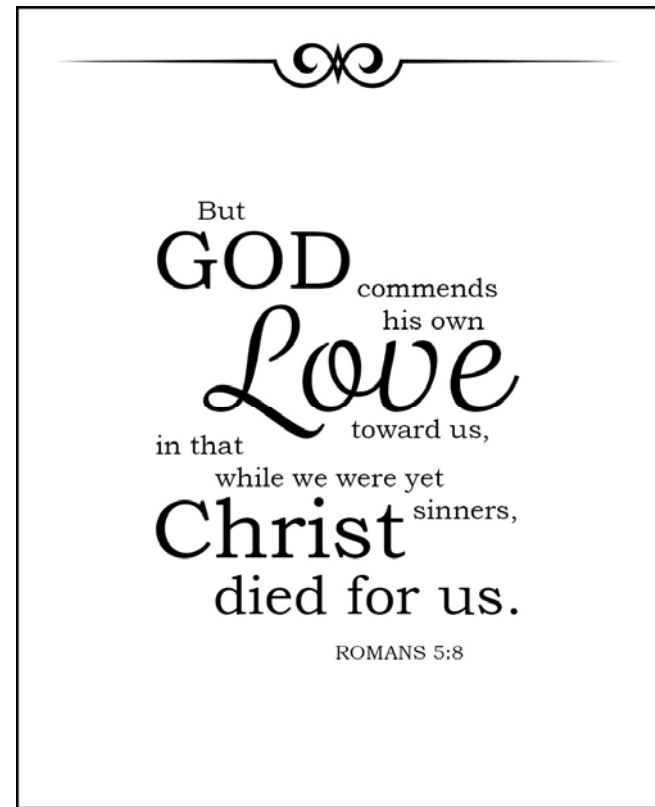
Announcements
