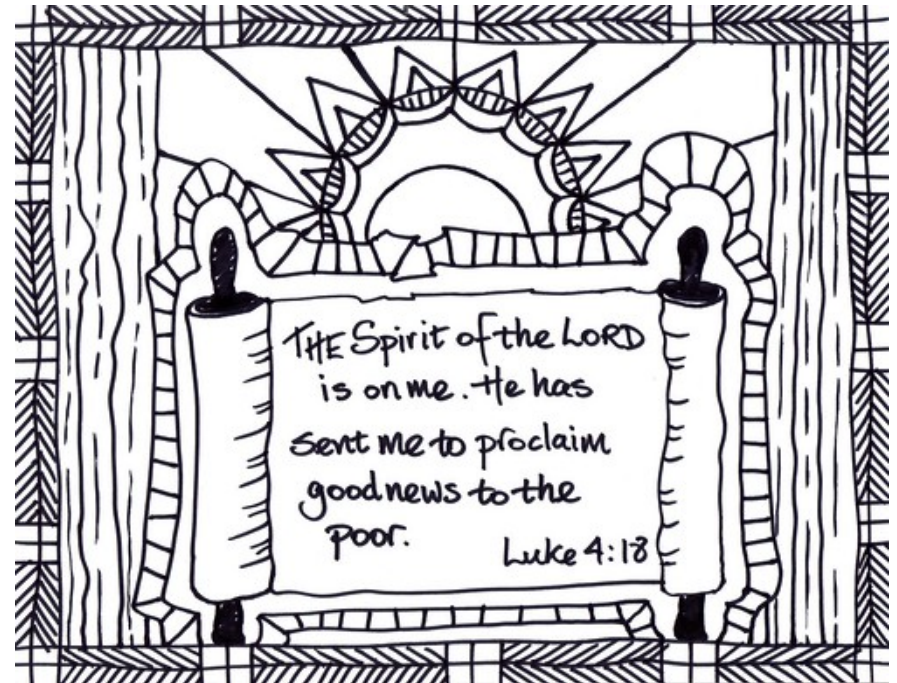


ANNOUNCEMENTS
