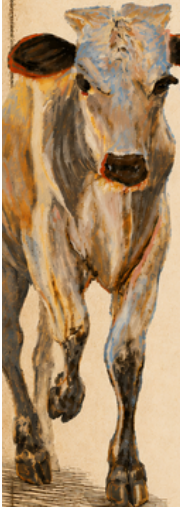

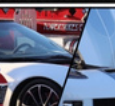

In reference to Ordinance #2003-03
Town of Lakeville Curbside Recycling of Yard Waste

Yard Waste Pick Up is every Tuesday from: April 1st – November 1st

- *Grass, leaves, vegetation, shrubbery only
- *Small limbs must be in paper lawn bags or disposable cardboard boxes.
- *Curbside pickup only-unless property is on Michigan Street.
- *Michigan Street pickups on alley or side street.
- *All paper bagged or boxed yard waste should not exceed 50 pounds.
- *All tree limbs and brush shall be separated from other yard waste.
- *All tree limbs and brush bundled and no more than 48"/4 feet long
