



MO Blues Jam Guidelines for Musicians

- 1. You must sign up to play –**
 - **Listen for your name to be called and know what position you are on the signup sheet**
- 2. The host/emcee will coordinate the jam groups and rotation of musicians**
- 3. Be ready to take the stage when your name is called -**
 - **Have your instrument ready to play**
 - **Be in tune**
 - **Have other accessories prepared/staged ahead of time**
 - **Bring an instrument cable, extra strings, picks and drumsticks**
- 4. Have respect and be courteous to all performers on the stage -**
 - **We are there to have fun, learn and enjoy the company of other blues artists/enthusiasts**
 - **Mistakes are OK**
 - **Performers are all different**
 - **Style**
 - **Experience and skill level –**
 - **MO Blues strives to accommodate all musicians at the sponsored jams.**
- 5. Be mindful of your stage volume-**
 - **This can be a positive or a negative effect for everyone involved with the show**

- ***Performers –***

- **Amplified Instruments**

- **Turn up a little when it is your turn to solo and then bring it back down**

- **Percussion**

- **Quite often the instrument volume is determined by the volume of the percussion. Play to the venue size**

6. Play songs that everyone can pick up on and play –

- **This is a BLUES JAM - Play the Blues**
- **Avoid playing original material or complicated/unfamiliar songs**
- **When in Doubt - Keep it simple**
- **Announce the key and chord structure/pattern**
- **Play NICE**
 - **Everyone should have a chance to take a solo**
 - **Wait for your turn to solo**
 - **Be a good supporter and backup/rhythm section**
 - **Show extra respect the equipment of others**
 - **Being heavily intoxicated does NOT enhance your performance - It is not safe or courteous for you, the performers, equipment, patrons and the venue**
- **MO Blues reserves the right to deny or limit participation**

7. Be courteous to the venue and staff

- **Please tip your wait staff**
- **Be a good customer -**
 - **Enjoy all the hospitality provided at the venue –**
 - ***Remember* - Food and Beverage sales paired with tips are how the venue and its employees make their living**
