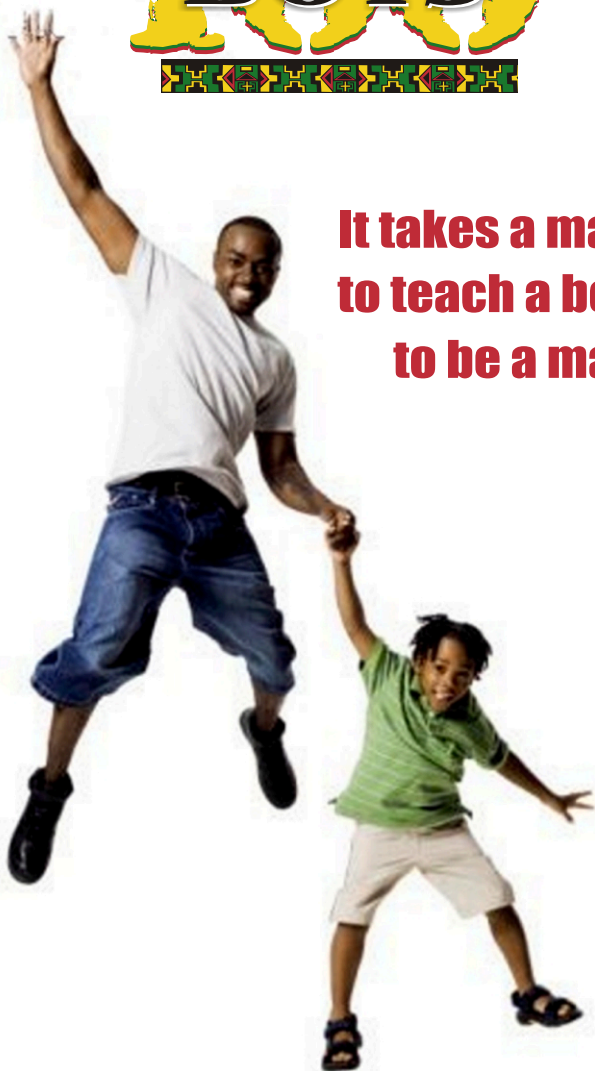

Mentors have the opportunity to guide boys toward development of their self-esteem, academic excellence, career goals and plans for the future.

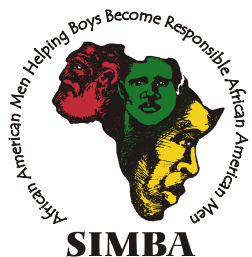


Simba mentors give children the opportunity to have positive and meaningful relationships with adults.
