GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Place your baked goods on a heavy-duty paper plate with NO name on the bottom – use two plates, if needed, to make it sturdy. Place inside a gallon size plastic bag or cover with plastic. Place your name, address, phone number and email on a 3 x 5 card or piece of paper. Also, indicate if you are entering the youth or adult category. Hand this card to the person registering your items and you will receive a number identifying your item. Include the recipe with your entry. If it's a secret recipe, just list ingredients, so when items are raffled, the buyer is aware.

For cookies: place **13** pieces on the plate. One will be used for judging and the other 12 will be auctioned off later in the day.

For pan baked items (brownies, bars, etc.): Cut in 2" squares when the items have cooled or chilled and place **13** squares on the plate and place in plastic bag or cover with plastic, if possible. 1 will be used for judging the other 12 will be auctioned off later in the day.

For breads or muffins – **1** regular loaf or **5** mini loaves for breads. **13** mini muffins or **7** large muffins.

For pies, use a disposable standard aluminum pie pan. Judges will cut one small slice out of the finished pie to judge. Please cover with plastic wrap or insert in a plastic bag.
