

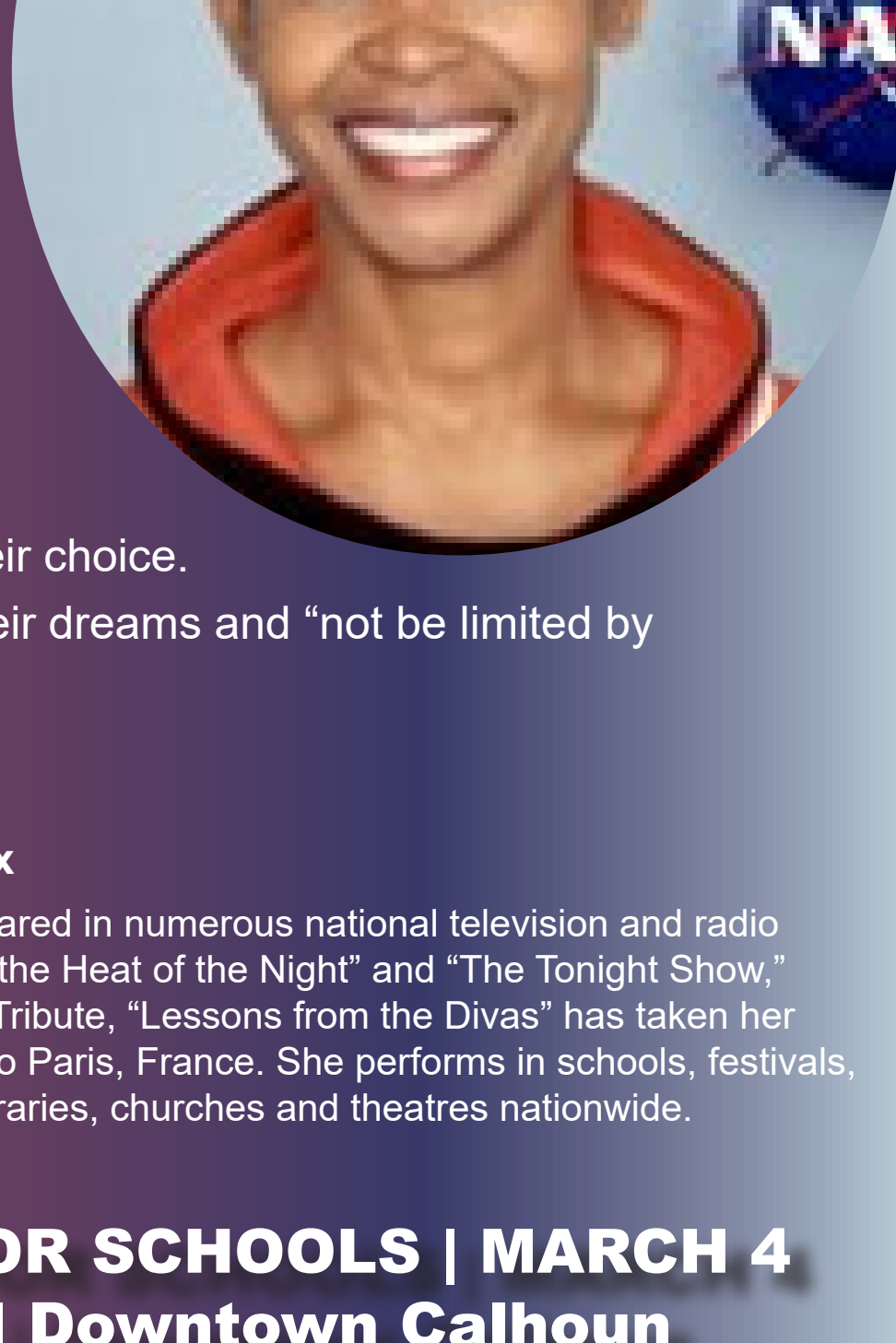

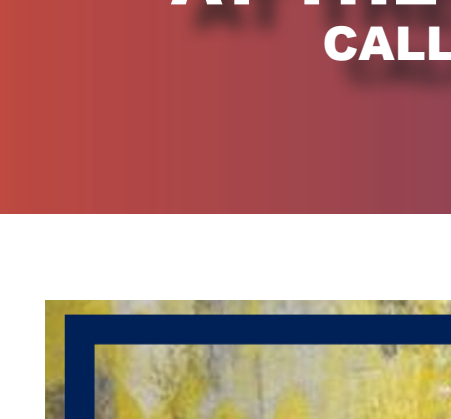

The student art can be viewed at the Harris Arts Center, 212 South Wall Street, through March 5.

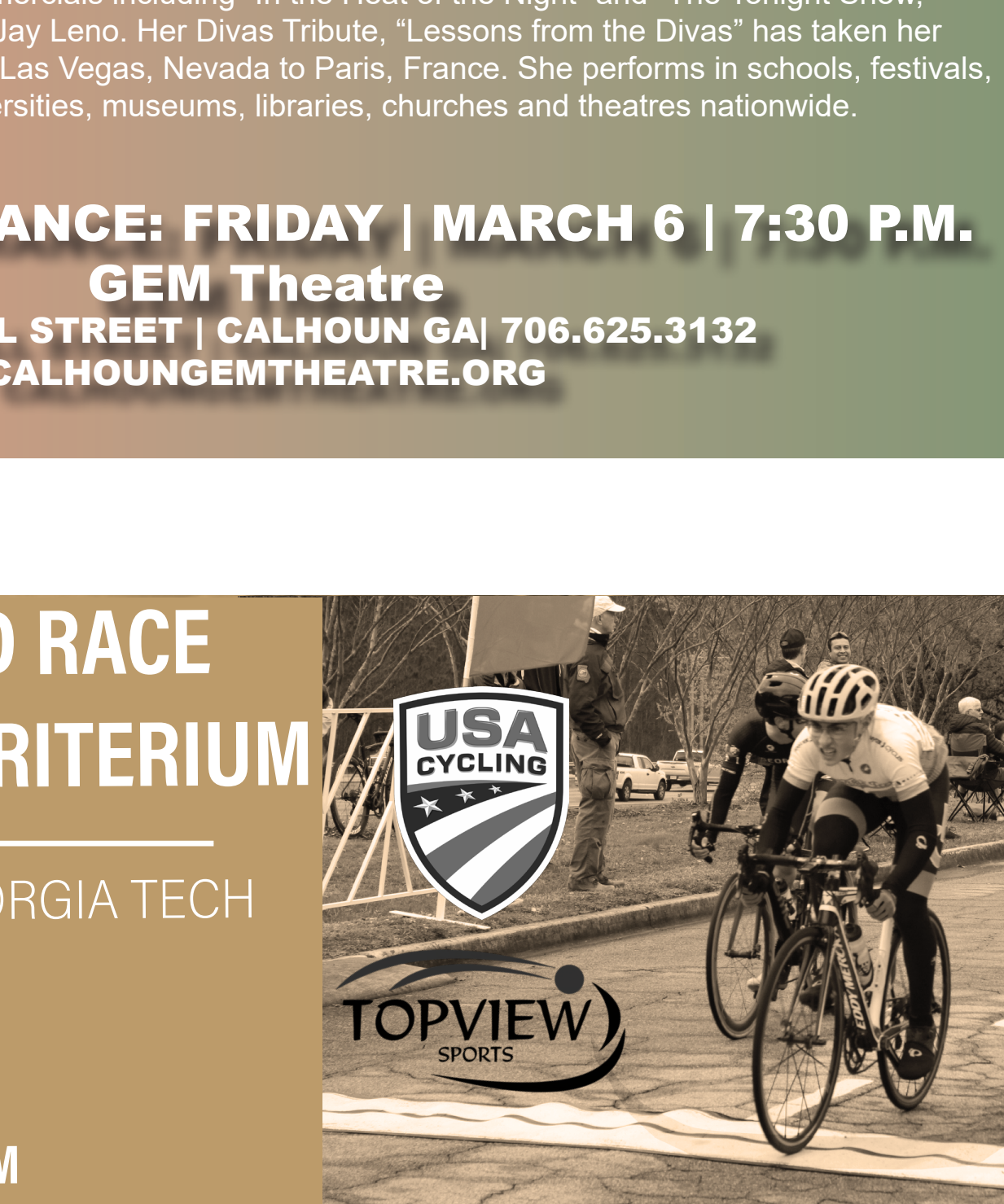
Free and open to the public, the arts center is open Monday 10:00AM-6:00PM,

## Raising a President

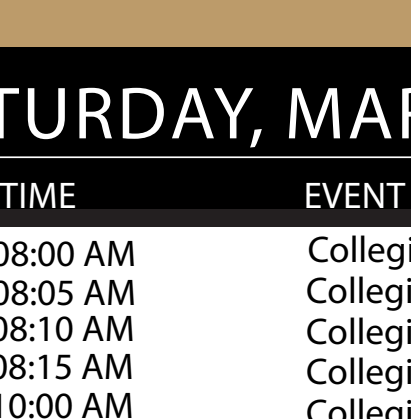
