Day 1:

Check in to **Cambria Hotel Savannah** and experience the architecture, history, and charm of coastal Georgia.

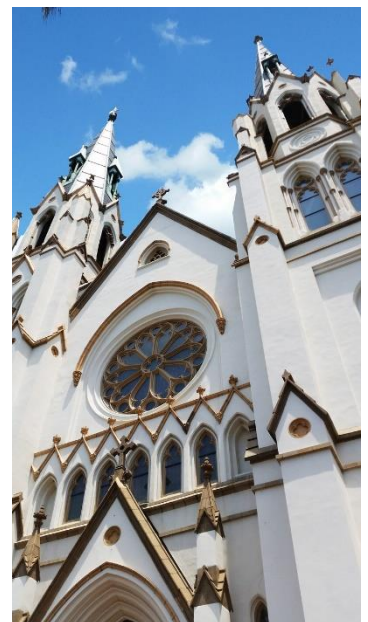
FREE NIGHT to explore – minutes from **City Market** and **River Street**.

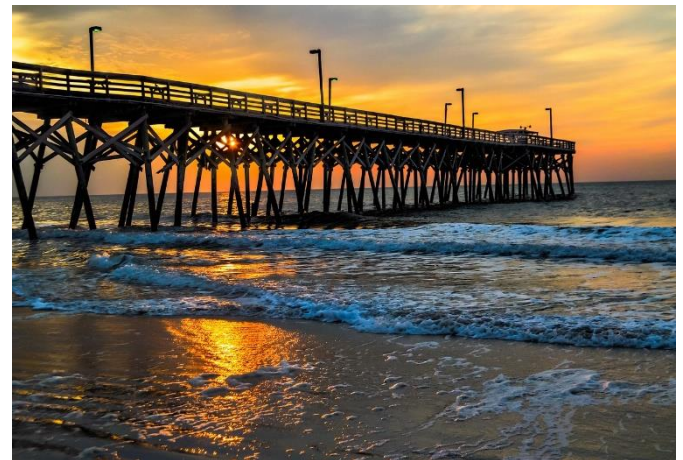
Day 6:
