



## March 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Lent

*Dear people*

*We tend to think of Lent as a time for stepping up acts of personal devotion and piety without giving much thought to its real purpose, which is an invitation to repent, be converted and return to the Lord our God. Like the Jews in the Gospel, who thought they were sinless and in good standing with God, we can fool ourselves into feeling that all is well.*

*We can also imagine that we are in good spiritual shape and have no need for repentance precisely because no casualty has come our way. We have to be mindful that the absence of misfortune does not mean the presence of virtue. Often it is not what we do wrong but the things that we leave undone which prevent us from growing in the love of Christ.*

*The real heartache is that we are guilty of sins of omission and neglect of which we are hardly even conscious. Without exception each one of us needs to make a better effort in caring, sharing, loving, and being available to our neighbour. It is not possible to do this unless we undergo a rigorous discipline of denying ourselves the comforts and luxuries we crave.*

*Our Lenten journey is a journey to produce the fruits of good living by loving God through our charity for others. Some questions for us to ponder...*

*- are we takers or givers? -is the reaching out to others putting aside our selfishness?*

*Lent is an opportunity for taking a hard look at our lives and asking how do we stand before God right*
