March 5th & 6th – 1st Sunday in Lent

Dear people, at the beginning of Lent the church places us before an open doorway and invites us to embark on a journey of spiritual growth. Like Jesus in the wilderness, we are being led by the Spirit into a forty-day period of prayer and fasting, to help us reflect on the direction our lives are taking.

It is an honest and frank attempt by the Church to make us come to terms with the reality of this pilgrimage we are on which will lead to our salvation. Lent is a time for us to get back to basics, to replenish the soil in which our Christian faith grows by curbing our selfishness and our pride.

In the desert Jesus is confronted by the forces of evil on three occasion and is subjected to severe temptations in the depth of His soul.
