MANAGER'S REPORT

Board Votes To Withdraw From Touchstone Energy

Il good things come to an end eventually. For Touchstone Energy and Choctaw Electric Cooperative (CEC), it's a business relationship that has simply outlived its usefulness. Your co-op board voted unanimously to end CEC's participation in the Touchstone Energy partnership at their monthly meeting in January.

Created in 1998, Touchstone Energy serves as a unified brand for some 600 electric co-ops nationwide and provides a number of broad-based marketing services to its participating co-ops. CEC used Touchstone Energy's website building and hosting services and particpated in the Coop Connections discount program.

For years, Western Farmers Electric Cooperative (WFEC) paid the \$16,000 annual Touchstone Energy membership fee for each of its member co-ops, including CEC. WFEC let us know earlier in the year that it may no longer pay these dues, effective January 2019. After careful evaluation and discussion of the value of Touchstone to CEC and our members, the board concluded that the costs simply outweigh the benefits.

CEC's in-house information technology staff are currently handling all duties related to managing the website. While the Co-op Connections card offers useful discounts on entertainment, travel, shopping and dining, these sort of discounts are now available through banks, credit card companies, the AARP and other outlets. Many of our members enjoyed the Co-op Connections pharmaceutical discount and used it regularly. For these members, we've compiled a list of similar discount Rx programs (*See chart above*) that provide similar benefits, but at no cost to your cooperative. We encourage you to look into these other options as soon as possible because the Co-op Connections card is no longer active.

There's no doubt that Touchstone Energy served the electric co-op industry well over the years, but our decisions now must be weighed in dollars and good sense. It's hard for CEC to justify paying \$16,000 a year for services that are easily available to our members for free. We hope you agree.

Spicy Garlic Lime Chicken

INGREDIENTS

- 3/4 teaspoon salt 1/4 teaspoon black pepper 1/4 teaspoon cayenne pepper 1% teaspoon paprika ¹/₄ teaspoon garlic powder 1/8 teaspoon onion powder 1/4 teaspoon dried thyme
- ¹/₄ teaspoon dried parsley 4 boneless, skinless chicken breast halves 2 tablespoons butter 1 tablespoon olive oil 2 teaspoons garlic powder 3 tablespoons lime juice

DIRECTIONS

In a small bowl, mix together salt, black pepper, cayenne, paprika, garlic powder, onion powder, thyme and parsley. Sprinkle spice mixture generously on both sides of chicken breasts. Heat butter and olive oil in a large heavy skillet over medium heat. Saute chicken until golden brown, about 6 minutes on each side. Sprinkle with 2 teaspoons garlic powder and lime juice. Cook 5 minutes more, stirring frequently to coat evenly with sauce.
