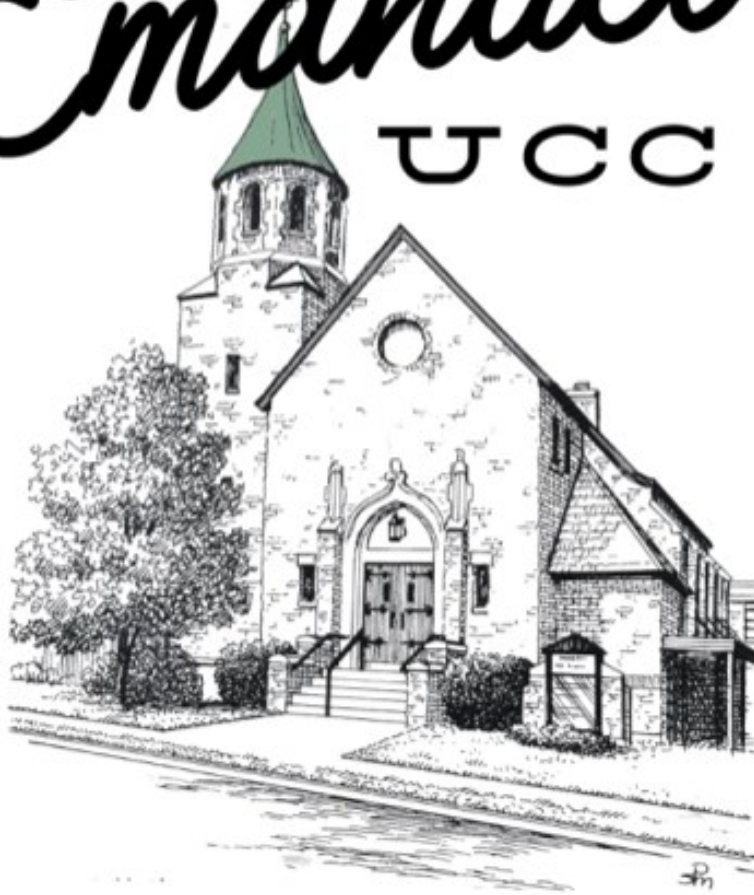

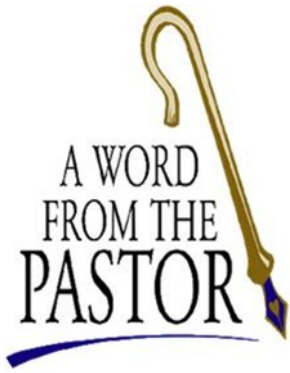

It's a new year with resolutions to make and thoughts of the things we want to change about ourselves or our lives. The key is setting small specific, achievable goals like, read one page of the Bible everyday or do one good deed a day.

We, the stewardship committee, will be setting our goals in a meeting on January 5. How can we be better stewards? How can we help encourage you to be better stewards? What can we do to support our church and community?

We want to encourage everyone to continue the support of the food pantry. You can do it with a monetary donation or by bringing in food to put in our barrel located by church bell.

Suggestions:

- * Peanut Butter and crackers
- * Spaghetti and Sauce with meat
- * Pancakes with syrup (get the complete pancake mix)
- * Soups
- * Stews
- * Vegetables
- * Canned meat (Vienna sausages, tuna, chicken)
- * Personal hygiene products
- * Sugar
- * Tea or Kool-Aid
- * Flour
- * Canned fruit
- * Powdered milk
- * Chili with meat

Most of us have never been food deprived or had to worry constantly about our next meal. If you have questions about the food pantry please ask Pastor Josh or one of the committee members.

We are going to actively start the Dime-a-Day program. Please give a Dime a Day for each member of the family for the whole year. The total is \$36.50 a year for each person in your family. This can be done online or in the collection plate. Be sure to write on your check and/or envelope, Dime-a-Day. The money collected will be used for special projects or needs of the church.

When you think about being a better steward, remember talents count. Sing in the choir, crochet or sew for the prayer shawl project. If you love to organize or clean, contact the office. If you like talking on the phone or writing letters, call the older people in your neighborhood and check on them, or write a note to someone who is not feeling well or is grieving. There are so many ways we can be good stewards. Smile at someone in the grocery store, help someone take their groceries to the car, pass it forward.

Come to church and support our church and our pastor. Watch online and share it with friends. Invite your friends to church. Give an offering to church so we can continue our mission work.

## **EUCC Council Meeting Minutes 12/14/25**

Members absent: Matt Zschille, Geoff Shinn, Layton Beggs

The meeting was called to order at 5:28 with an opening prayer by Pastor Josh.

Previous minutes were available for review. Motion for approval of previous minutes made by Kelly and seconded by Matt R. Council approved.

Treasurer and Financial reports given by Pat Holley. Will file for audit.

## **Report of Committees**

### **Buildings and grounds report:**

- The parsonage back door was repaired by Matt. He will add weather stripping soon.
- Jimmy installed a handrail at the clothing closet.
- The boiler is on and working.
- The parsonage heat is not keeping up. Langford suggests cleaning the ductwork due to buildup. Josh was quoted \$950 from Air Solutions and \$450 from Semo Solutions for 12 vents / \$10 per additional vent. Matt R. motioned to have the ducts cleaned and also purchase a safe heater for the back porch to keep that area warm enough. Kelly second. Motion passed.
- Matt kept the church a little warmer and cabinets open to save heat and pipes.
- Jimmy replaced the thermostat on the kitchen refrigerator. It seems to be working now. May look into using a digital thermostat when needing another repair.

Audit committee report: Will meet again in January. Will need new committee members.

Rental property: All is well.

Clothing Closet: Nine people came yesterday. Clothing will need to be reorganized during January.

Stewardship Committee: All is well. The quilt went to Joy Kessler. Made over \$100.

CBE report: Will meet in January. The children's Christmas program is next Sunday during church.

Lay Service/ Member Care report: A church member would like a ride to church once a month.

Worship report: All is well.

Head Usher report: Have moved to using 2 ushers for offering when necessary. Will keep 4 for communion.

## **Pastor Report with notes from Pastor Joshua Rau**

- Pastor Josh looked into creating a church Venmo Account for offering. We can create a non-profit account through Venmo & PayPal for 1% administrative fee. Matt suggested we add the Venmo along with the Breeze online giving. Katie motioned to approve. Matt seconded.
  - Worship services coming up are the continued Wed night Advent services, Christmas Eve @ 10:30 PM, & Christmas Day @ 10:10.
  - Jesse that teaches guitar is happy with his rental of the space.
  - There is a baptism on Dec 21.
  - The new facility use agreement went out to members last week. We will use this agreement for all events. Katie suggests getting a copy of the Jackson R-2 liability for any school events. Matt will look into this.
- Pastor Josh will be gone on Jan 24-25, 2026. He will have a lay member-led worship

## **•Old Business**

Church Mutual Insurance Quote was received. We're waiting on the renewal quote from the Insurance Board before choosing coverage for 2026. Pat received a quote from the Insurance Board but the information wasn't updated and they will have to send a new quote. Pat will send an email ASAP to make a final decision before the end of 2025.

Pastor Josh's licensure was approved.

The Ministerial Alliance sent a thank you for the food pantry items received from the live nativity.

Jimmy read a letter from OCWM asking about donations.

The elevator is currently not up to code and the business we have used no longer has an inspector. Debra sent quotes about other companies and OTIS looks like the best option for us. We discussed the \$140 or \$190/month plans. Katie moves to use the OTIS plan that includes the annual fees. Matt seconds. Motion passed.
