



EUCC Council Meeting 7/20/25

Previous minutes were available for review. Motion for approval of previous minutes made by Matt R. and seconded by Pat. Council approved.

Treasurer and Financial reports given by Pat Holley. Will file for audit.

Report of Committees

Buildings and grounds report:

1. Weeds have been sprayed.

- 2. Wasps & mud dobbers have been removed from the bell tower.
- 3. The basement A/C drain has been repaired, but still needs a cover to prevent it from being bumped again.
- 4. The source of the rainwater near the elevator in the basement is still a mystery.

Audit committee report: None

Rental property: 1. New renter - Lydia Shinn. Approved by the council. Will receive keys after signing lease and paying deposit & rent.

Clothing Closet: Was open on 7/12

<u>Stewardship Committee</u>: Louise St. John is having surgery again and will need to step down as Chairwoman of this committee.

CBE report: Water event on 7/19 went well. Final summer event is the church picnic on 8/3.

<u>Lay Service/ Member Care report</u>: Pat Abernathy is OK with not getting a ride to church currently because of health issues.

Worship report: All is well. Head Usher report: None

Pastor Report with notes from Pastor Joshua Rau

- 1. With the new Ignite Worship space location in the new fellowship hall, if the new fellowship hall is rented out for an event it needs to conclude by 4:00 PM on Saturday evenings to allow enough time to be converted into a worship space. Matt R. motioned to update the Facility Usage form to reflect the time change. Pat seconded. Motion passed.
- 2. KHIS radio has Ministry Partners instead of selling advertisements. Each \$20 donation gets you a 30 second ad and promotional mentions. To help increase awareness of the Ignite Worship, Pastor Josh recommended a \$160/month partnership. Individuals or businesses can be the Ministry Partner to pay for those advertisements and are also mentioned. Matt R. motioned to do a 6 month partnership and Emanuel will pick up the monthly expense if not paid for by an individual or business. Kelly seconded. Motion passed.

Old Business

New picture directory. The last one was made in 2016. Council decided to look into making one on our own. Submitting our own pictures or setting up a date for people to get digital pictures made if they don't have a suitable picture to submit. Group pictures could be taken on a Sunday morning. An example from St. John's UCC, which was made with Shutterfly, was passed around. Kelly will ask around for anyone interested to spearhead this project.

New Business

- 1. Church insurance review. A meeting with our current provider (UCC Insurance Board) is scheduled for Monday 7/21 at 6:00 PM. A meeting with Church Mutual is scheduled for Wednesday 7/23 for an agent to take pictures and submit a quote.
- 2. Passing of the Peace Several members have commented that it seems awkward in its placement in the service, but want to continue having it. Suggested by Council to keep it in the worship service but move it earlier in the service and have a song/Gloria Patri following to help facilitate getting people back to their seats, minimize the length of time allowed and give the congregation a way to know that the service is continuing on.
- 3. Kelly and Jimmy will form the nominating committee
- 4. Budget Committee will meet on Thursday, Aug 21 with Kelly, Geoff and Matt R as council representatives

Meeting adjourned at 9:34 with motion by Matt R. seconded by Geoff with the Lord's prayer led by Jimmy.
