


As we journey through this season together, let's strive to embody the love that builds bridges, heals wounds, and shines the light of Christ in a world longing for hope.

Previous minutes were available for review. Motion for approval of previous minutes made by Matt R. and seconded by Kelly. Council approved.

Treasurer and Financial reports given by Jimmy with notes from Pat Holley. Will file for audit.

- 1. On recommendation from Pat, Kelly motioned to transfer \$20,000 from the General Fund CD if no penalty or UC Fund. If there is a penalty, use the one with the least. Matt R. second. Motion passed.
- 2. Pastor's housing allowance investment vehicle was tabled until Pastor Josh and Pat Holley have more conversations.

Decision on type and kind made at a later date.

The Congregational Meeting was set for February 23, 2025




