



Previous minutes were available for review. Motion for approval of previous minutes made by Layton and seconded by Geoff. Council approved.

Treasurer and Financial written reports were provided by Pat Holley. Will file for audit.

The bank resolutions and officer resolutions were presented. No changes were made. Geoff moved to accept as presented. Matt seconded. Motion passed and copies were signed after the meeting.

Report of Committees

Buildings and grounds report:

Possible Replacement of the rental house roof. The tenant reported a leak after the storms. A short term fix was applied. Check with insurance to see if they will cover any of the cost to replace. Brandon Hill will provide quotes to either replace only the ridge cap or replace the entire roof.

The Clothing Closet shelving was donated by RubberMaid and installed by Matt Roethemeyer for free. The ladies love it.

Audit committee report: None

Rental property: The one year lease ends in Aug.

Clothing Closet: 12 people came on April 12

<u>Stewardship Committee</u>: Auction follow up, working with CBE on the Summer Series. Will meet at the end of the month.

<u>CBE report</u>: Having Easter breakfast & Bingo. Having a summer series instead of VBS which will be held one Sunday in each month of June, July and August.

Lay Service/ Member Care report: None

Worship report: All is well

Head Usher report: All is well

Pastor Report with notes from Pastor Joshua Rau The website was updated with social events. The Confirmation Class made blessing bags for homeless shelters. ½ will be delivered to Cape and ½ will be delivered to St. Louis.

Old Business

There was discussion about possibly upgrading to a larger dumpster because it is usually full by Thursday after Wednesday's pickup. Council wondered if other businesses are using it or if the public is using it. The public is using the dumpster and we are routinely being charged for overages. Wallace is the only one using it. 2019 is the last time they paid anything towards the cost of the dumpster. Republic Waste was the best option to switch to. Matt motioned to switch to a 4 yard locked bin with Republic and ask other businesses to offer a donation. Katie seconded. Motion passed.

Bookkeeper position - Send to PSRC to make a job description.

Tabled from March minutes: Kelly brought up the question if Congregational Meetings should be streamed. Do the online watchers add to the quorum? Can online viewers vote or ask questions during the meeting. All questions should have to be addressed in the bylaws and a protocol established if another platform is used such as Zoom. Matt said he can stop the church service stream. Start a new stream for the congregational meeting and make it private on YouTube only.

New Business

New picture directory. The last one was made in 2016. Council decided to look into making one on our own. Submitting our own pictures or setting up a date for people to get digital pictures made if they don't have a suitable picture to submit. Group pictures could be taken on a Sunday morning. Need to check printing costs and someone willing to put it together.

Pastor Sam celebration of 50 years in the ministry. It will be held on June 8, 2025 which is Pentecost Sunday. There will be a meal and meet and greet following church.

Next meeting: May 11, 2025 (Mothers Day)

Meeting adjourned at 9:09 with motion by Geoff, seconded by Jimmy with the Lord's prayer led by Jimmy.


