On Sunday, May 10 our graduates were recognized during worship. We wish them good luck as they enter a new chapter in their lives.

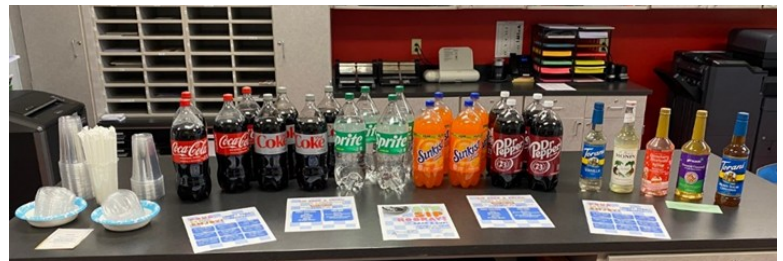
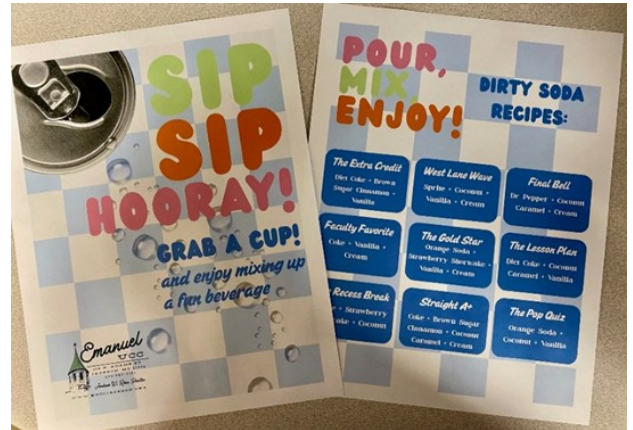
**Clara Beggs**—Clara graduated from Jackson High School. She will be attending Southeast Missouri State University and major in Elementary Education.

The meeting was called to order at 8:02 with an opening prayer by Pastor Josh

Previous minutes were available for review. Motion for approval of previous minutes made by Kelly and seconded by Pat. Council approved.

Treasurer and Financial reports given by Pat Holley. Will file for audit. Matt R. motioned to use dedicated Clothing Closet funds to repair the window instead of Seabaugh funds. Kelly seconded. Motion passed.

## **Report of Committees**

### **Buildings and grounds report:**

1. The windows have been ordered from Jackson Glass to repair the Clothing Closet and the parsonage.
2. We received a second quote on the sanctuary A/C repair from Peters Service Co. It was over \$6000 higher. Council recommended taking the Langford quote to the congregation for approval.
3. Cintas recommended replacing the exit sign light batteries. They are over 20 years old. Matt will get a quote on replacing batteries.
4. The digital thermostat for the large refrigerator in the kitchen has been received and will be installed soon by Jimmy.

**Audit committee report:** All is well. Will meet in June.

**Rental property:** All is well.

**Clothing Closet:** Had 6 people on 5/9 and another lady earlier in the week.

**Stewardship Committee:** Haven't met since last month

**CBE report:** Will start working on adding another Sunday School class. They are planning on Nursery-1st grade, 2nd-7th grade, 8th & up. They are planning on sending out a postcard mailer for the different ages inviting them back when they get the curriculum established.

**Lay Service/ Member Care report:** All is well.

**Worship report:** All is well. Roxie will fill in for Ann after her surgery.

**Head Usher report:** All is well

### **Pastor Report with notes from Pastor Joshua Rau**

1. Emanuel has been asked to host the Eastern Association meeting on Oct 4, 2026 at 3:00 PM. Zoom capabilities are required. We will also need to provide light refreshments.
2. There was discussion about discontinuing or changing the time for the Ignite Worship service. Council suggested taking a break over summer. The last service will be May 23. Ann suggested having a small group or study group during Sunday School. Geoff suggested having the Ignite service at 8:00 on a Sunday morning may get more people to it and Sunday School. We will have more discussion as summer progresses.

### **Special EUCC Congregational Meeting 5/24/26**

Below are the unapproved minutes from the May 24, 2026 Church Council Meeting. Minutes will be approved at the next council meeting.

The meeting was called to order at 11:19 by Jimmy McCormack. Pastor Josh opened with a prayer.

The purpose of this meeting was to approve replacing an A/C unit for the sanctuary. Matt Roethemeyer told the congregation that we have had a unit that has been fixed over the past few years. Langford Mechanical had identified the compressor on the unit wasn't working. Their assessment was that it would be more expensive to repair than to replace. Langford's bid to replace the unit was \$17,580. A second bid was received from Peters Service Co for \$23,700. Limited bid options existed since this was a commercial unit. It would be paid for from the Seabaugh Fund which is strictly for maintenance and repair of the church. The Council recommended to accept Langford's bid. There were no questions from the congregation. Layton Beggs motioned to accept Langford's bid. Shirley McCormack seconded. Motion passed

Jimmy reminded the congregation about the Visioning roundtable meeting on June 6, 2026. There would be a pot-luck lunch at noon followed by the meeting. Catherine Hartle said she couldn't attend the meeting, but wanted to know what the options were. Jimmy said the options would be emailed out to the congregation on Thursday, June 4.

The meeting adjourned at 11:24 with a motion by Catheryn Hartle, seconded by Matt Roethemeyer. Motion passed.

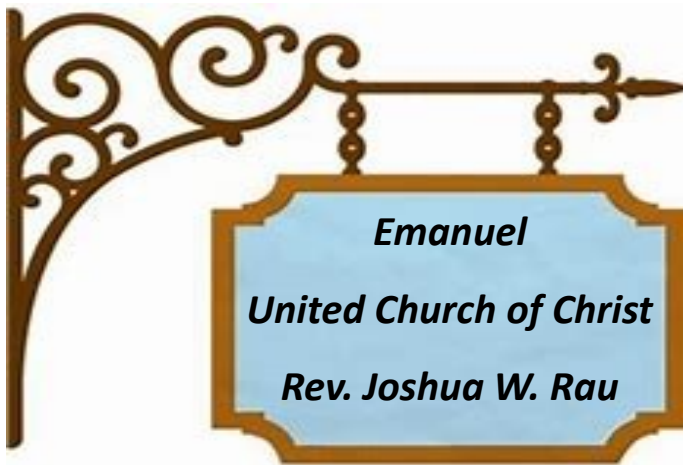
