January Weather Forecast

A GLANCE AT THE WEATHER FOR THEMONTH AHEAD.

January in Cairns is a vibrant blend of tropical warmth and refreshing rains, offering a unique charm for visitors. Here's what you can typically expect:

Temperature:

January stands as the warmest month in Cairns, with average temperatures around 28°C (82°F). Daytime highs often reach up to 31.7°C (89°F), providing perfect conditions for beach outings and exploring the Great Barrier Reef or local waterfalls. Evenings are pleasantly warm, with lows averaging 24°C (75°F), ideal for alfresco dining and nighttime strolls.

Rainfall:

As part of the wet season, January brings increased rainfall, contributing to the lush, green landscapes that define the region. On average, Cairns receives about 385 mm (15.2 inches) of rain during this month, typically spread over 16 days. These showers often occur in the early morning or late evening, leaving the daytime hours open for activities. It's not uncommon to experience clear blue skies interspersed with brief, tropical showers that quickly pass.

Humidity and Winds:

The tropical climate brings higher humidity levels, averaging around 77%. While this adds to the sultry ambiance, the coastal breezes provide a pleasant counterbalance, making short outdoor adventures enjoyable.







Other Weather Forecasts

Cyclones:

January falls within the cyclone season in Queensland. However, significant cyclonic events are infrequent. Local authorities maintain vigilant monitoring, ensuring public safety with timely updates and preparedness measures.

Sunshine and Daylight:

Despite the increased rainfall, Cairns enjoys a generous amount of sunshine in January, with approximately 6.5 hours of sunshine per day. The days are long, averaging about 12 hours of daylight, providing ample time to explore and enjoy the natural beauty of the region.

Sea Temperature:

For those eager to dive into aquatic adventures, the sea temperature in January is wonderfully warm, averaging around 29°C (84°F). This makes it perfect for swimming, snorkeling, and other water activities.
