

2022-2023 Application Packet



Our admissions process helps us to best serve your family as well as our school's vision and community. Our school has a vision for developing conservative leaders who will influence the world through their life. Please read this page carefully to understand your part in the admission process.

- 1. Visit our website or our school to learn more about classical consertative education. No other system of education has the track record of success that classical education does, but it makes you rethink what you know about education. We encourage you to do your homework.
- 2. Request and Complete an application. Send an email to Registrar@Privested.org and place "Request an Admissions Application" in the subject line. Privested Academy has rolling admissions. Grade capacity is limited each year. We will continue to accept applications on a wait list basis after capacity has been met.
- **3.** Pay the Application fee. Upon submission, you will be invoiced the application fee. The application fee is per student non-refundable electronically through the invoice.
- 4. **Research Classical Education.** This information will help guide you in understanding our bible based foundation. Please be prepared to ask any questions you may have during the parent interview.
- 5. Bring in your student for testing and interview. New students are tested to determine their academic and behavioral preparation for Privested Academy. No specific score is required. Rather, we judge the general preparation of the student in core subjects like math, reading, and writing. Students can receive a waiver based on prior institution.
- 6. Students are assessed based upon:
 - 1. Admission test results
 - 2. Student attitude and behavior
 - 3. For older students, their contribution to our school community

Each year we successfully admit many students from many different school backgrounds.

7. Attend a parent interview. All parents or guardians are interviewed by an administrator at our school. This helps us to assess new applicants based on our school's mission and culture.

8. Families are assessed based upon:

- 1. Family support
- 2. A family faith that aligns with our statement of faith
- 3. A basic understanding of classical conservative education

Acceptance and admittance. Completed applications will be processed first on the family and student fit as determined by Admissions Committee. Applications received without a paid application fee will not be considered. Students will be accepted based on the information collected above. Acceptance means that we believe that we can serve your family and there is a fit with our community. In classes that are full, students who are accepted are then wait-listed until we have room to admit them. A student is admitted only when we have a seat for them in a classroom. No further money is required until a student is admitted.

A note on our waitlists: We do not assign a ranking to our waitlists. Once a list is ranked, students are generally admitted in the order of their rank. However, several factors can result in the list being re-ordered. For example, the enrollment of current families with siblings in older grades, holding back a student into a grade, or the employment of a new teacher with a student in a full grade can result in the list being re-ordered.

1. Non core day electives are included in the full week program tuition. Summer and special electives are not included.

2. Testing fee is paid directly to ERB for the Independent Schools Entrance Examination (ISEE). ISEE testing will begin in the 2023-2024 school year.

3. The New Student Enrollment Fee is a one-time fee and will be included in your Payment Plan. It is discounted 50% for the third and subsequent siblings in a family.

4. Monthly payments shown above exclude the Application Fee and the Testing Fee since these are paid prior to enrollment. The calculation includes the one-time New Student Enrollment Fee, the annual \$50 Installment Plan Fee and 1.75% Tuition Reimbursement Plan, and assumes a 12 month payment cycle (March - February). For students starting payments after March, the payment schedule will be compressed since the last installment is due in February.

*Families purchase their student's uniforms at Mills Uniforms. Some classes require books and on-line resources which are purchased by PA; parents will be invoiced directly for these materials. The costs above are estimates based on new textbooks and non-sale prices for uniforms.

Payment Plans

Families may choose from 3 payment plans. Tuition insurance is available for all options and is mandatory for the monthly installment option.

One Payment: pay in full by March 5; or if enrolling after this date, then by the 5th of the month following enrollment.

Two Payments: pay 50% by March 5 (or if enrolling after this date, then by the 5th of the month following enrollment) with the balance due July 5. Must be enrolled by June 1 to select the two-payment option.

Monthly Installments: pay equal monthly installments by automatic bank draft or credit card March through February. Students enrolling after March will have a compressed payment schedule with final payments due in February. An annual \$50 Tuition Management Fee is as-sessed per family for the monthly payment option and participation in the Tuition Reimbursement Program is mandatory.

Tuition Reimbursement Plan: 1.75% of core tuition is required for installment plan accounts and is optional for pay-in-full plan accounts.
