

The PennQuest Odd Age Novice State Championships

Sunday, March 22nd, 2026

Welcome to the PennQuest Odd Age Novice State Tournament! This is for 1st and 2nd year wrestlers only. This tournament will reverse the division birth years and give wrestlers who are at the bottom of their age division all season a chance to compete at a state championship without an age disadvantage.

Note that wrestlers with more than two years of experience must compete in the PennQuest Odd Age Youth Open State Tournament (held the same day). Just a reminder that any challenges to Novice eligibility must be made by 3:00 p.m. on Saturday (3/21). No prior qualification is needed, register now to secure your spot at www.pennquest.org.

Tentative Start and Weigh In Times: Note that these times are subject to change slightly once registration is finalized, to create as efficient of a tournament as possible. **You must check back at noon on March 21st for finalized start times.**

Awards: PennQuest State Placement Trophies will be provided to the top four placers.

Rules: All matches will be three periods with choice of position for the second and third period. Only Pennsylvania Wrestlers are eligible for this event. Twelve-point technical fall. Tournament will be random draw, no wrestlers will receive seeding.

Tournament Eligibility: This tournament is for first and second year Pennsylvania wrestlers only. Wrestlers with more than two years of experience must compete in the Youth Open Division State Tournament. Any challenges to Novice eligibility must be made by 3:00 p.m. on Saturday.

Registration: \$50 - All wrestlers must register online, no walk up or same day registration. Register at www.pennquest.org. Registration closes on Thursday, March 20th at 10:00 p.m.
