Opportunities to Boost Well-being

We are so happy to be back for the new 2026/2027 school year. The wellness programs at the Bashaw School will continue for all students from Kindergarten through to Grade 12. Students needing emotional or crisis support can access a variety of available programs and services, including:

- Donna Ashman, Student Wellness Facilitator- Donna can be found at the school on Wednesdays. She can be accessed through a referral system by parents or guardians at the school level.
- Trish Rasmussen, Behavioral Health Consultant- Trish is at the school on Mondays but is additionally at the Bashaw and Area Community Resource Centre, Tuesdays and Wednesdays. She supports children, youth, seniors, families and adults with a no charge counselling service. A referral system is in place to see Trish through connection with the Bashaw and Area Community Resource Centre.
- Lori Miller, Family Wellness Worker- Lori is part of the Bashaw and Area Community Resource Centre wellness team. Lori works at the school Monday to Friday and sees students from Kindergarten to Grade 12. She works one on one with students or in small groups, acting as a bridge to other supports as needed, or is an in-the-moment support for other immediate care. She also finds value in supporting the Drama programs, as the goal is to provide a safe caring environment to explore creative endeavors and create a strong sense of belonging.
- Claire's Closet- This resource is also a large part of the wellness services in place at the Bashaw School. Claire's Closet is a space in the school stocked with everyday essentials such as food, snacks, toiletries, hygiene supplies as well as socks and other items. It is available to anyone, as needed, and is accessible without any barriers. There has been an added element of shoes provided if needed and just requires a quiet awareness so that supplies may be obtained.

Please don't hesitate to set up care for your child by one of the many supports within the Bashaw School and community, through the Bashaw and area Community Resource Centre.

National Day for Truth and Reconciliation

Each year, September 30 marks the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation.

The day honours the children who never returned home and Survivors of residential schools, as well as their families and communities. Public commemoration of the tragic and painful history and ongoing impacts of residential schools is a vital component of the reconciliation process.

This federal statutory holiday was created through legislative amendments made by Parliament.

Wear orange

Both the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation and Orange Shirt Day take place on September 30.

Orange Shirt Day is an Indigenous-led grassroots commemorative day intended to raise awareness of the individual, family and community inter-generational impacts of residential schools, and to promote the concept of "Every Child Matters". The orange shirt is a symbol of the stripping away of culture, freedom and self-esteem experienced by Indigenous children over generations.

On September 30, we encourage all Canadians to wear orange to honour the thousands of Survivors of residential schools.

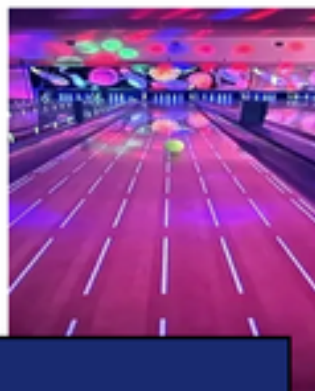

The Camrose Association for Community Living – Healthy Families Program is dedicated to empowering families and caregivers to foster the healthy development of children during their early years.

Healthy Families Program: What Do We Do?

The Healthy Families Program offers prenatal and parenting support services from pregnancy through to a child's 6th birthday. Operating on the principle that strong, secure relationships between caregivers and children are fundamental to healthy development, our program focuses on cultivating secure attachment relationships, promoting early childhood development, and addressing the specific needs of families within their home environments.

Our Approach

Our Home Visitation Facilitators work closely with families, providing personalized information and support to nurture healthy child development. Through tailored home visitation services, we encourage families to actively participate in planning their home visits. Collaborating closely with community partners, we ensure a holistic approach that meets identified family needs and raises awareness of available community supports.

PCAP (Parent-Child Assistance Program)

Building on our commitment, PCAP extends specialized, holistic support to individuals confronting substance use and other health or social issues. Home Visitation Facilitators provide personalized services over three years, guiding participants and families through these challenges with compassion and expertise. Participants embark on a three-year journey where Home Visitation Facilitators support connections to essential services—from substance use recovery and mental health treatment to navigating legal, housing, and income assistance programs. Our approach is grounded in stages of change, self-efficacy, and harm reduction, ensuring each participant receives empathetic support tailored to their unique circumstances.

How to Access Our Programs

Our Healthy Families program welcomes referrals from everyone - individuals or families seeking support, as well as from parents, doctors, public health nurses, social workers, teachers, prenatal instructors, and community agencies. All our services are voluntary and provided free of charge, ensuring accessibility for all families in our community. We support families in the areas of: City and County of Camrose, County of Beaver, County of Flagstaff.

FASD Announcement for September

FASD ALBERTA NETWORKS RECEIVE MINISTERIAL APPROVAL FOR USE OF "LET'S GET REAL" RESOURCES IN ALBERTA SCHOOLS

We are pleased to announce that Alberta Ministry of Education and Childcare has approved the FASD Networks of Alberta as External Party Presenters and the "Let's Get Real" learning and teaching resources for use in Alberta schools.

The approval follows 2025 amendments to Alberta's Education Act requiring Ministerial approval for learning and teaching resources and external parties that provide resources dealing with human sexuality content. While the primary focus of "Let's Get Real" is FASD prevention, healthy decision-making, and awareness of the effects of alcohol use during pregnancy, some resources include curriculum connected human sexuality topics such as contraception and healthy sexual decision making. Effective June 9, 2026, the "Let's Get Real" Presentation (Grades 8-12), Tips Booklet, and Tip Sheets received Ministerial approval. This approval confirms that both the resources and the FASD Alberta Networks have successfully met Alberta Education and Childcare's review requirements and may continue to support schools across the province with evidence-informed prevention Education.

The FASD Alberta Networks also offers "Let's Get Real" versions for grades 8 to 12 without human sexuality content for schools that prefer those resources.
