
What does team-based care look like?

Aging Well in Your Community

If you are an older adult, needing extra support at home or with your daily routines, we may be able to help. Programming for older adults includes Meals on Wheels, Home Support Outreach (learn more below) and transportation.

Please note Meals on Wheels fees will increase to \$10 per meal, as of March 1, 2025.

How does it work? Hot meals are delivered to your door, on Mon, Wed & Fri. A 3-course lunch prepared at Bashaw Meadows. Call to place your order!

Do you need help to get to your medical appointments? The Bashaw Regional Transportation program is a door to door service designated to support Healthy Aging in the region. Eligible riders are those age 50+ who live within the areas of Bashaw, Donalda, Alix, Mirror, Mecca Glen, Ferintosh, Edberg, Meeting Creek and everywhere in between; those who need transportation services to medical and other health related appointments, who do not drive, or do not drive in the cities where their appointments may be and who are attending short-term appointments.

Priority to those who do not have other supports, family members or means of transportation available. Each service request is evaluated on a case-by-case basis and must meet screening prior to approval. **Set Round Trip Fees Apply.***
